



understand key considerations, opportunities and challenges to use professional English in an effective way


Special Needs



Special Needs Teacher Training

Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) is a type of therapy that focuses on improving specific behaviors, such as social skills, communication, reading, and academics as well as adaptive learning skills, such as fine motor dexterity, hygiene, grooming, domestic capabilities, punctuality, and job competence.

ABA is effective for children and adults with psychological disorders in a variety of settings, including schools, workplaces, homes, and clinics. It has also been shown that consistent ABA can significantly improve behaviors and skills and decrease the need for special services.

ABA methods and techniques can be used to help children with special needs improve social skills, self-care skills, communication skills, play skills, and behavior management. It can also help reduce challenging behaviors such as inattention, aggression and screaming.


ABOUT **EAP COURSE**

Course Introduction

This EAP course is a bridging course with the preschool education major in Canada. The goal is to improve international students' professional English proficiency in early education and child care. This program is for students who want to study in a preschool qualification program in Canada or who want to teach in an international kindergarten in China. This professional English bridging course will enable students to improve their English proficiency and gain a preliminary understanding of the Canadian preschool education qualification. Upon successful completion of the bridging program, you will receive assistance from your partner in applying for admission to a Canadian institution.

ESL/EAPEnglish for Academic Purposes

The fundamental goal of the EAP program is to help students improve their basic and professional English skills. Different advanced courses are offered according to students' needs and abilities to improve their language skills.
